Holiday Recycling



Many items commonly used throughout the holidays are recyclable. Look for such items as:
Paper packing materials from boxes, newspaper, cardboard, carbonless paper, box board, colored paper, magazines, catalogs, plastic and glass bottles, cans & clean aluminum foil. Wrapping paper that is not glossy or coated with plastic



However these abundantly used seasonal items cannot be recycled:
Styrofoam & Styrofoam/ plastic packing materials * Ribbons & bows * String * Tape * Foil-lined paper * Paper with plastic coatings * Waxed paper (such as deli wrap, photographs) * Tyvex (non-tearing) envelopes * Paper tissue/towels * Food-soiled paper

What's Recyclable?

Everyday there seems to be that little something that makes us pause and wonder "where does this go; in the trash or in recycling?" Below is a list of items commonly viewed as confusing:

***Plastic cups:** all beverage cups numbered 1-7 are recyclable and can go into the blue cart

***Toothbrushes:** are recyclable they can go into the blue cart

***CD's/ VHS :** are recyclable e-waste and can be taken to NRWS Recycling Center at **920 American Way**, Free of charge

***Plastic wrap: not recyclable,** must go into the trash, best bet is to use tin foil which is recyclable.
