\$\$About the Rate Increase

Effective July 1st, you may have noticed an increase of 1.53% to the monthly collection rates. Please note that NRWS does not implement increases without careful review. Increased operating costs have bounced up and down such as yours, the ratepayer. This increase directly reflects the true cost of the disposal tipping fee increase at the landfill and a 0.30% Cost of Living Adjustment. There shall be no further rate increases through June 30, 2010.

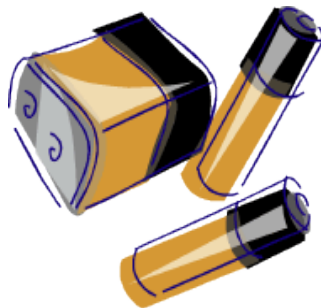

The Federal Department of Transportation is now enforcing a requirement that All Batteries have their contacts taped prior to being shipped over public roads after consolidation.

Household Batteries and Automobile Batteries contain Hazardous Material. Placing them in the garbage is a danger to the environment, the hauler and landfill staff. Recycling them is free at NRWS Recycling Center, 920 American Way.

Oil Filters* Pesticides *Aerosols * Bleaches
* Solvents * Pool chemicals * Hobby
supplies *Mercury thermostats &
thermometers * Latex & Oil-based paints
* E-waste * Herbicides *Poisons *Paint
Related Products (thinner, stains, varnish,
& lacquers) *Polishes Batteries * Medical
Sharps * Pharmaceuticals * Household
Cleaning supplies * Fluorescent blubs *
Chemical fertilizers.

Unacceptable Items:

Ammunition * Explosives * Radioactive
waste * Smoke detectors * Tires * Garbage.
